## NICS Numbers for October 2020 – More Record Gun Sales

(AmmoLand.com)- During October 2020, the National Instant background Check System (NICS) checks and numbers of gun sales set new records for the month once again. The number of checks was 3.3 million. The calculated number of gun sales was more than 1.74 million. The previous record for checks in October was last year, with over 2.39 million checks.

About half of the background checks done in the NICS system are now done for carry permits or carry permit re-checks.

In October 2019, the number of gun sales was 1.06 million. The October 2020 number is 1.64 times the number sold in October 2019. This is in line with the trend for 2020, which is about 1.7 times that of 2019.

1.74 million guns sold in October of 2020 brings the total sold in 2020 to about 16.84 million. To break past 20 million for the year, 3.16 million will need to be sold in November and December, or about 1.58 million per month. Those numbers can easily be achieved. November and December are traditionally high months for gun sales.

2020 is not a traditional year. Politics and the fear of unrest, of police

ordered to stand down in many Democrat cities and states, of a push to ban the most effective defensive tools such as semi-automatic rifles and pistols, have pushed gun sales to all-time records.

The election did nothing to alleviate the apprehensions which have led to record gun sales in 2020. Former Vice-President Biden has repeatedly called for mandated turn-ins or registration of the most popular rifles in



the country. His running-mate, Senator Kamala Harris, former Attorney General of California, has a long history of extreme anti-right to keep and bear arms positions.

The appointment of Amy Comey Barret to the Supreme Court, along with the almost certainty of the Republicans holding the Senate, means the threats of packing the Supreme Court will not happen even if the Biden-Harris ticket is victorious.

The extremely close election, in spite of nearly five years of full-on political advocacy and propaganda

by nearly all the old media against a candidate, then President Donald Trump, means the Progressive power elite has lost much of its power to manipulate and control the American Electorate.

If President Trump loses the election, the aggressive, private, coordinated censorship of conservative voices, including Second Amendment supporters, by the tech giants of Google, Facebook, and Twitter, bear considerable responsibility.

The nail-biting character of the election, and the extreme distrust of the election numbers generated by the conduct of the media, portend more record levels of gun sales and background checks.

If President Trump loses the election, efforts by the Democrats to restrict Second Amendment rights guarantee high gun sales. If President Trump is re-elected, gun sales may subside, but probably not.

More than 20 million guns will be sold in 2020. According to NSSF, about 40% of those sales are to new gun owners. Most of the sales are for self-defense. Higher percentages than ever before are to minorities and women.

At the end of October, there were, according to the calculated numbers, over 458 million privately owned guns in the USA.

# Announcing Winston84: A Directory to Suppressed Content

The Center for American Greatness is pleased to announce a new resource for lovers of the First Amendment, a searchable directory - [Winston84](#) - to online content that has been censored.

The phenomenon of online censorship, which has steadily increased over the past few years, hardly requires explanation. Beginning in earnest in 2016, the censorship disproportionately impacts conservatives and nationalists, who find their social media content “shadow-banned,” “deboosted,” “throttled down,” “demonetized,” or, in the ultimate (and very common) sanction, “deplatformed.” All too often, these content providers even have their websites taken down by their ISP providers, and their online fundraising accounts terminated.

For those of us paying attention, these attacks by online communications monopolies have been unrelenting, but the censorship has reached new extremes. A few weeks ago, Twitter made it impossible to post a link to an article about content potentially-embarrassing to



then-candidate Joe Biden, published by one of the oldest newspapers in America. Meanwhile, Facebook and Twitter censored social media accounts belonging to the Trump re-election campaign 65 times.

The recent wave of censorship goes well beyond presidential politics.

In just the last three weeks, YouTube, following similar actions by Facebook and Twitter, deleted more than 30 channels with significant audiences which they identified as posting “Qanon conspiracy theories,” along with countless smaller channels. But the real threat posed by the Q collective is not just its most sensational and controversial topics, but rather the relentless uncovering of government corruption by thousands of online sleuths. The suppression of Q is one of the most ominous displays of censorship in our time.

Over the summer, we saw blatant censorship of doctors who merely advocated more research and access to hydroxychloroquine as a preventive and early-stage treatment for COVID-19. Does HCQ work in certain cases? We still don't know. But censoring public debate on this question is wrong.

For example, a video featuring emergency room doctors who offered a dissident opinion from mainstream media and big pharma got over 17 million views within a matter of hours, before Facebook pulled it from its platform. President Trump's re-tweet of this video was taken down by Twitter, along with those of other high-profile Americans, including Donald Trump, Jr.

Describing these events, one of America's last remaining unmuzzled mainstream dissidents, Tucker Carlson, had this to say on July 29: “While the rest of us were sleeping, or in the case of so many of our senators, taking money from Google, a tiny number of left-wing corporations took virtually complete control of all news and information in this country.”

Carlson is right, and this is a problem of historic scope. In America today, when content disappears from the major social media platforms—Facebook, Twitter, YouTube—a huge percentage of Americans, 50 percent or more, will never see it.

This is information warfare, and First Amendment advocates are in a race against evolving AI programs wielded by communications monopolies. People can share links to suppressed content. If the links are blocked, they can put the links into a different article, and share the link to that article. If deep links are banned, they can cut and paste the text into a new article. If text strings are banned, they can avoid using key-

[Parler](#). [DLive](#). [ThinkSpot](#). These and many others provide an alternative for content producers driven off of YouTube, Facebook, and Twitter.

The mission of Winston84 is to collect and catalog online voices that have been deplatformed, demone-

tized, shadow banned, or otherwise suppressed, and provide links to their platforms. We may or may not share their opinions, but we support their right to be heard. If someone is thrown off of YouTube, we track their migration. If you search for their record in Winston84, you will see links to all the known platforms where they are active.

# A Survey of Pro-Second Amendment Groups

(AmmoLand.com)- One thing that often causes hot debates is the question of which pro-Second Amendment group to support. Should Second Amendment supporters go with the National Rifle Association, which has been around for nearly 150 years? How about Gun Owners of America, and its famous "No Compromise" policy? What about the Second Amendment Foundation, responsible for a number of legal victories?

Believe it or not, there are a number of pro-Second Amendment organizations out there – some devoted to state issues, others taking a national focus. Here is a rundown on the major ones.



## National Rifle Association

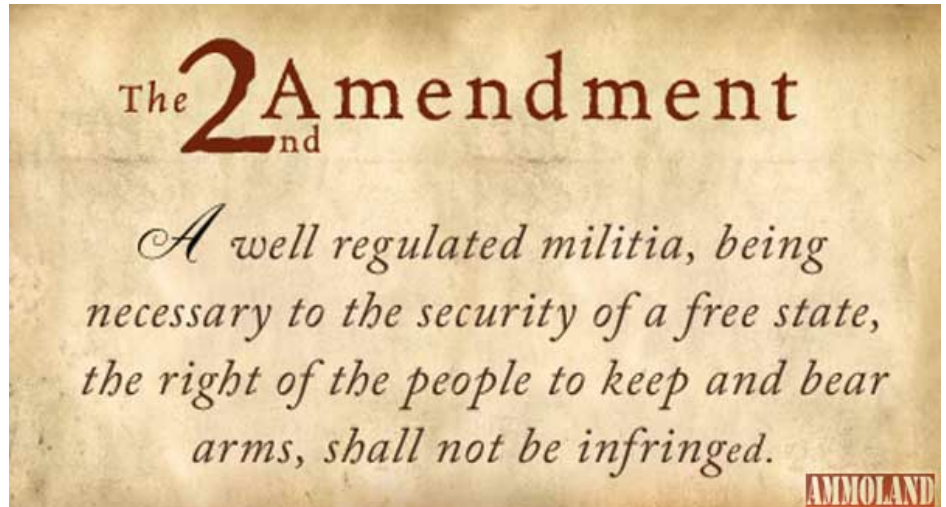
Membership: Between 5 and 6 million.

Founded: 1871

The NRA is the largest pro-Second Amendment organization in the United States. In addition to the lobbying, the group also does firearms safety training, law enforcement training, runs competitions, and provides hunter services.

While some criticize it for the high salaries executives receive and an appearance of "compromising" on Second Amendment fights, it should be noted that the NRA has been the major target of the anti-Second Amendment extremists, going back decades – even before the 1977 Revolt in Cincinnati led by Harlon B. Carter.



## Gun Owners of America

Membership: About 1.5 million

Founded: 1976

In the wake of a handgun ban being introduced in California, then-state senator H. L. Richardson founded Gun Owners of America as a "no compromise" group.

While it is pro-Second Amendment, it seems to spend as much effort damning the NRA for being insufficiently pro-gun as it does in targeting anti-Second Amendment extremists. On the other hand, it does have the effect of making the NRA's pro-Second Amendment advances look reasonable. GOA was founded months before the Revolt in Cincinnati.



## Second Amendment Foundation

Membership: 650,000

Founded: 1971

The Second Amendment Foundation has primarily worked on legal and educational efforts. Founded in 1974, it initially was intended to be an adjunct to the Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms, which was formed in 1971 as a lobbying group long before the NRA's focus shifted after the Revolt in Cincinnati.

While the NRA eclipsed it in lobbying, SAF has become a major player in litigation against laws that violate the Second Amendment. The group also issues several publications. The group has also adopted a number of gun-rights groups, notably Jews for the Preservation of Firearms Ownership and Doctors for Responsible Gun Ownership.

# A Survey of Pro-Second Amendment Groups

This organization provided a lot of research, mostly by pointing out a connection between the 20th century's worst genocides and laws that disarmed the intended victims. The organization promoted Bill of Rights Day and was largely run by Aaron Zelman until his death in 2010. The group then was "adopted" by the Second Amendment Foundation, which has preserved its research.



## Students for Concealed Carry

Membership: 40,000

Founded: 2007

Founded in the wake of the Virginia Tech shooting (the college was a gun-free zone), this group has pushed for allowing students with concealed carry permits to carry on their college campuses. In addition to having a national leadership, the organization has over 350 chapters in colleges across the country, help-

ing a new generation of pro-Second Amendment activists prepare to take over the defense of our liberties.



## Firearms Policy Coalition

Membership: Unknown, but Facebook page has over 300,000 likes and they have about 23,400 Twitter followers.

Founded: 2013

This group, primarily centered in California, has carried out litigation and grassroots efforts. Among its projects are litigation against the bump-stock ban, California's latest semi-auto ban, and California's magazine ban. The organization has also taken on Massachusetts Attorney General Martha Healey over 3D-printed guns, and is fighting Taser bans in Annapolis, Maryland and New York state.

# Who's Who in Firearms - Part 8

*Small Arms Lexicon and Encyclopedias, Chester Mueller and John Olson, Shooter's Bible, South Hackensack, News Jersey, 1st Ed., 1968*

**Maxim, Hiram Stevens** (1840-1916) - Prolific inventor of firearm improvements, born in the U.S. but went to England in 1882. He was the brother of Hudson Maxim and known as the father of semi-automatic firearms as they are known today.

**Maxim, Hudson** (1855-1927) - Joined his brother, Hiram, in England from 1886-1888, but returned to the U.S. He invented several improvements in explosives.

**Maynard, Edward** (1813-1891) - An American dentist and inventor. In 1845, he invented a tape primer used in U.S. military weapons and, in 1851, invented an improvement in breech loaders that became Maynard rifles and carbines.

**McClellan, Samuel Neal** - Inventor of the machine gun made famous by Col. I.N. Lewis after he added improvements and sold it to the military after 1910. It became known as the Lewis Machine Gun.

**Metford, William Ellis** (1824-1899) - English engineer who developed a rifling system of seven grooves in 1865. Combined with the bold action of James P. Lee, it became the Lee-Metford magazine rifle in 1888. It was the first magazine-fed rifle used by the British Army, later to be replaced by the Lee-Enfield rifle.

**Minie, Charles Claude Etienne** (1804-1879) - French Army Captain who developed a conical lead ball with an iron cup in the base, known as the Minie Ball.

**Nobel, Alfred Bernhard** (1833-1896) - Swedish inventor who produced dynamite in 1863, as well as other explosives, smokeless powders, and cordite. He established the Nobel Prize in his will.

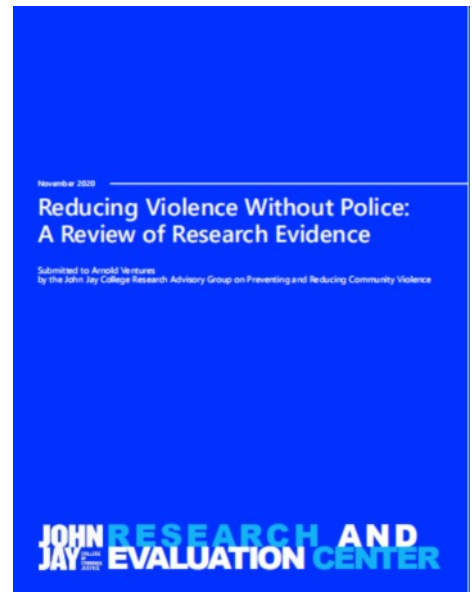

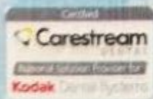

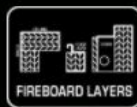
