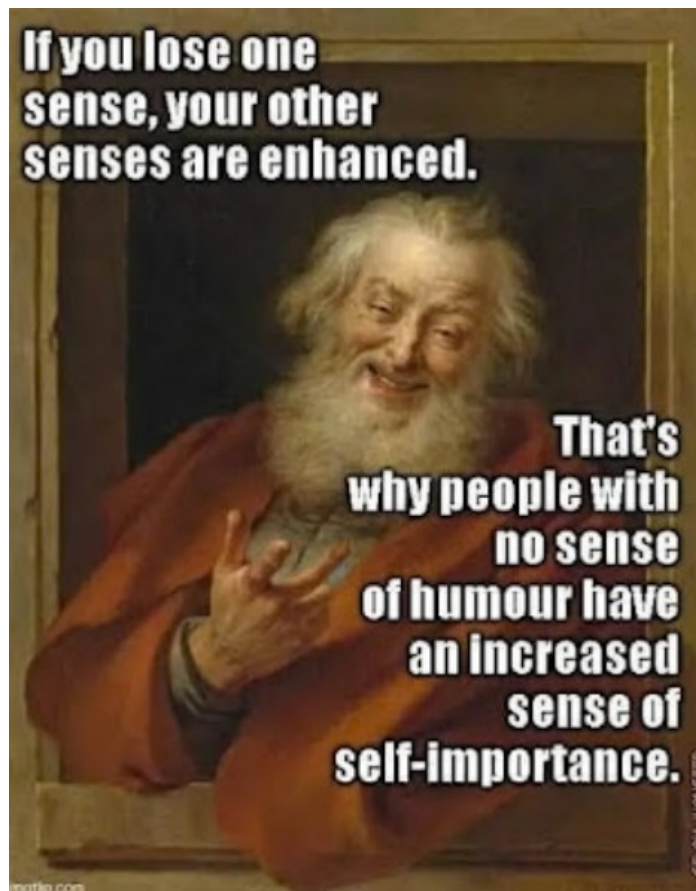

The Fundamentals of Marksmanship – The last one is seriously underrated. Let's outline why it's crucial.....

- Stance
- Grip
- Sight alignment
- Sight picture
- Trigger control
- Breath control
- **Follow-through**

Follow-through

- Isn't as easily understood as the others
- Tends to be deemphasized
- Considered an afterthought since it comes after the shot

Results of lack of follow-through

- Missing your target
- Failing to stop the target
- Failing to detect additional threat(s)

Components of follow-through

- **Mechanical** ("hard-skills" developed from training; can be performed on auto-pilot)

- * Ensuring your gun is ready for a following shot, if necessary
- * Resetting the trigger for the next shot
- * Reacquiring the sights
- * Reloading the gun if it's empty
- * Clearing a malfunction if it's present
- * Must be mastered to free the mind to perform the Mental

- **Mental** ("soft skills" that are less predictable and depend on practicing the mechanical)

- * Assessment, Decision-making, and Adaptation
- * Ready to take additional shots if necessary
- * Maintaining your sight picture after each shot to help ensure you hit your next shot
- * If you bring your head up, the muzzle will go down, causing the shot to miss
- * Keeping the sight picture sets you up for accurate follow-up shots
- * You need to be able to fire until the threat is stopped
- * Track the target to the ground and assess ability to provide a deadly threat
- * Scan for additional threats after initial threat has been neutralized
- * From neutral or high-ready position, rotate your head and torso
- * Scan with your eyes and move the gun to follow them
- * Turning your head helps eliminate the "tunnel vision" that can occur, expanding your peripheral vision if additional threats exist
