



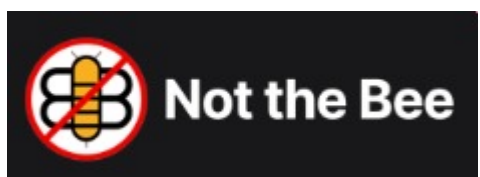

# The Colorado Freedom Force

## **SB23-168 - Gun Violence Victims' Access To Judicial System**

This bill wants to hold gun industry members liable for third-party criminal acts, by “knowingly or recklessly creating, maintaining, or contributing to a public nuisance.” It is possible a gun sold lawfully could later fall into a criminal’s hands, whether through theft, secondary transfer, or some other circumstance wholly beyond a manufacturer’s or dealer’s control. If every such occasion could subject an industry member to liability, it would be all but impossible for businesses that support the Second Amendment to exist.

## **SB23-169 - Increasing Minimum Age To Purchase Firearms**

Raises the age to purchase a firearm to 21. If passed, this would harm youth hunting. Individuals who are old enough to vote, join the military, or enter into contracts should also be allowed to purchase firearms. Raising the age limit is an unnecessary restriction on personal freedom and choice. Also, raising the age will not stop criminals from stealing firearms, getting them on the black market, or getting them from straw purchasers. It will only infringe on the Second Amendment rights of law-abiding citizens.

## **SB23-170 - Extreme Risk Protection Order Petitions**

This bill seeks to expand Colorado’s “red flag” gun confiscation scheme by allowing additional “qualified” individuals to determine who will act out in dangerous and unlawful ways ahead of time and confiscate their firearms to prevent this from happening. Second Amendment rights are taken away based on mere speculation and hearsay evidence. “Red Flag” orders, or Emergency Risk Protection Orders, are designed to empower the government to confiscate Americans’ firearms without due process of law. They can lead to the violation of citizens’ rights.

## **HB23-1219 - Waiting Period To Deliver A Firearm**

This bill requires a 3-day waiting period between firearm purchases and possession. Criminals will not be affected by waiting periods. Proponents of the waiting period claim it is a “cooling off period” that supposedly gives the prospective buyer time to reconsider their intentions and protect against impulsive actions. This argument has no logical basis. Two-thirds of gun owners own more than one gun. A cooling-off period for these gun owners could not possibly have an effect, as they already own other firearms.

## HB23-1230 - Prohibit Assault Weapons in Colorado

Anti-Second Amendments always struggle to define exactly what an "assault weapon" is, yet they want to ban them anyway. This bill is no exception.

Inside the language on how to define what an "assault weapon" is, you will find statements such as:

"The high velocity of the typical assault weapon bullet damages and destroys tissue as it travels through the body, causing organs to become liquefied" - this is an exaggeration.

"The typical assault weapon bullet leaves the barrel of the gun three times faster than a typical handgun bullet" - this is not true... it's about 2x.

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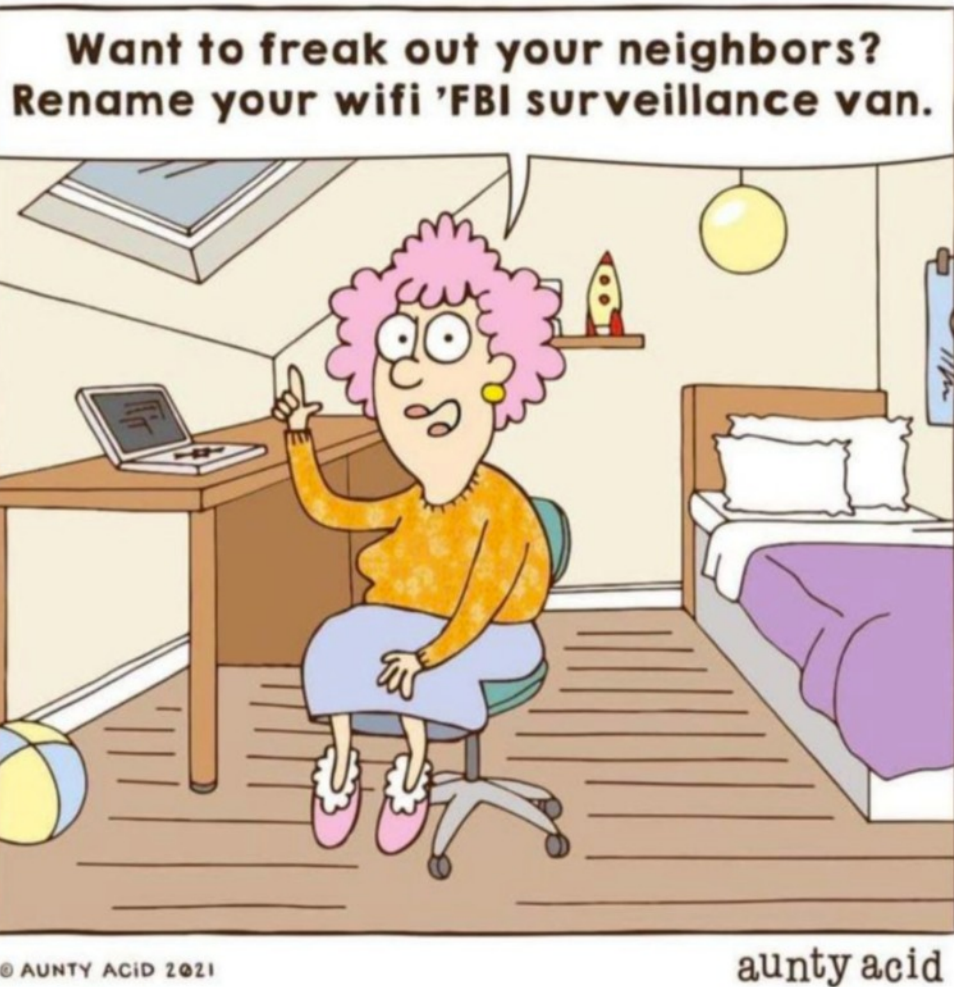
