Our newsletters have placed a lot of emphasis on the package of anti-Second Amendment bills this session, and will continue to do so as long as they loom in the Legislature.

They are:

SB23-168 - Allowing gun manufacturers and stores to be sued.

SB23-169 - Increasing minimum age to purchase a firearm to 21.

SB23-170 -Expansion of the "Red Flag" law.

HB23-1219 - Three day waiting period to purchase a firearm.

All four of these bills passed their original chamber, and have been referred to the House or Senate for additional committee hearings there.

Together, we must continue to make our voices heard in Denver!

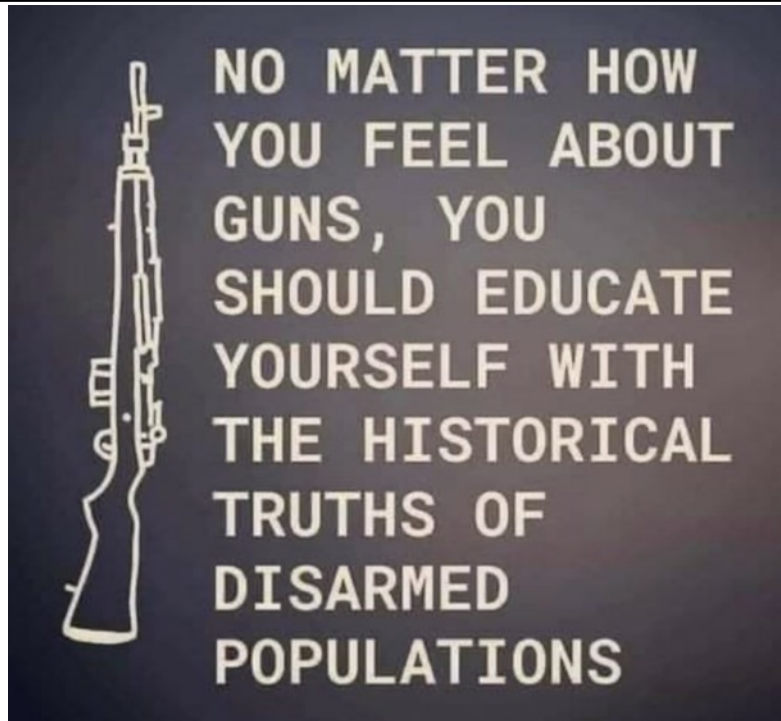

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U.S. COPYRIGHT OFFICE - FAIR USE DEFINITION:

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Section 107 contains a list of the various purposes for which the reproduction of a particular work may be considered fair, such as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, and research. Section 107 also sets out in four factors to be considered in determining whether or not a particular use is fair:

1. The purpose and character of the use, including whether such use is of commercial nature or is for nonprofit educational purposes
2. The nature of the copyrighted work
3. The amount and substantiality of the portion used in relation to the copyrighted work as a whole
4. The effect of the use upon the potential market for, or value of, the copyrighted work
