



### Level 4: Accelerationist Terrorism

Violent radicals who have abandoned the political process and electoral strategies, and have turned towards terrorism to trigger the long-awaited race War. Examples: The Order, Atomwaffen Division, National Action, The Base, National Socialist Legion, Iron March, Fascist Forge

### Level 3: White Supremacists , aka The Alt-Right

White Nationalists, Neo-Nazis, and Fascists. Has different levels of openness, from the suit & tie 'Identitarians' to the white hooded Ku Klux Klan. Examples: National Policy Institute, Generation Identity, Southern Nationalist Movement, American Identity Movement, Patriot Front

### Level 2: 'Alt-Lite'

The alt-right's more mild-mannered sibling. Libertarian, pro-israel, usually (but not always) distances themselves from White Supremacists and fascists, either for moral or PR reasons. Examples: Patriot Prayer, Proud Boys, Patriot Movement, Oath Keepers, Anne Coulter, Mike Cernovich, Boston Free Speech, Three Percenter Militias

## Level 1: Mainstream Conservatism

Your average red state, Christian-Conservative Republicans. Examples: Establishment GOP, Christian Broadcast Network, FOX News, Sean Hannity, Tea Party Movement, National Rifle Association

### The Firearms Coalition of Colorado 05-27-2023 Legislative Alert-Urgent-State and National Issues

There is a sit-in planned by anti-Second Amendment activists at the State Capitol on Monday, 06-05-2023 to demand that the Governor issue an executive order banning all guns in Colorado and calling for the confiscation of currently owned firearms through a "buyback" program. It will be interesting to see how many members of the "Nobody wants to take your guns/common sense gun law" Caucus in the State Legislature show up at the demonstration. Since the Governor was reportedly unwilling to support a semi-auto ban THIS YEAR, during the Regular Session of the Colorado General Assembly, he will probably be unwilling to consider an even more tyrannical executive order. We believe it is an appalling symptom of the moral and intellectual decay in this state that a group of Leftists would even consider such a radical and obviously unconstitutional proposal.

The BATFE Pistol Brace Ban was scheduled to take effect on 06-01-2023, however, a 3-Judge Panel of the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals has issued a temporary restraining order blocking implementation of the ban in a case supported by the Firearms Policy Coalition. The extent of the effect of the restraining order does not appear to be clear at this time. Gun Owners of America, which submitted an Amicus Brief in support of the lawsuit, is urging that citizens contact their US Senators and Representatives and urge them to pass House Joint Resolution 44 and Senate Resolution 20, which would stop the BATFE anti-Second Amendment rule. Please contact your Federal Public Servants and urge them to support the resolutions.

The US Supreme Court has refused to take a case that would have stopped the Illinois Semi-Auto Ban from going into effect during litigation on the constitutionality of the measure. Biden has repeated his call for a Federal Semi-Auto Ban. Please contact your Federal Public Servants and urge them to vote against any such legislation.

It is important to let elected officials know your opinion, even if they oppose your views. Liberals need to know there is significant, principled opposition to their intended course of action, or they will assume that no one cares and will pursue even more outrageous proposals.

While contacting elected officials is important, elections are the most important factors in determining if we are to keep our birthright of freedom recognized by the Second Amendment. Elections determine who runs the legislative process at the state and federal levels, and who controls the boards, councils and commissions for local districts, cities and counties. Please do as much as you can to assist in the effort to elect pro- Second Amendment candidates in 2024. Remember that a Third-Party Vote is a wasted vote.



Copyright Disclaimer under section 107 of the Copyright Act 1976, allowance is made for "fair use" for purposes such as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, education and research.

Fair use is a use permitted by copyright statute that might otherwise be infringing.

Non-profit, educational or personal use tips the balance in favor of fair use.

#### FAIR USE DEFINITION:

Fair use is a doctrine in the United States copyright law that allows limited use of copyrighted material without requiring permission from the rights holders, such as for commentary, criticism, news reporting, research, teaching or scholarship. It provides for the legal, non-licensed citation or incorporation of copyrighted material in another author's work under a four-factor balancing test. The term "fair use" originated in the United States. A similar principle, fair dealing, exists in some other common law jurisdictions. Civil law jurisdictions have other limitations and exceptions to copyright.

#### **U.S. COPYRIGHT OFFICE - FAIR USE DEFINITION:**

One of the rights accorded to the owner of copyright is the right to reproduce or to authorize others to reproduce the work in copies or phonorecords. This right is subject to certain limitations found in sections 107 through 118 of the copyright law (title 17, U.S. Code). One of the more important limitations is the doctrine of "fair use". The doctrine of fair use has developed through a substantial number of court decisions over the years and has been codified in section 107 of the copyright law.

Section 107 contains a list of the various purposes for which the reproduction of a particular work may be considered fair, such as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, and research. Section 107 also sets out in four factors to be considered in determining whether or not a particular use is fair:

- 1. The purpose and character of the use, including whether such use is of commercial nature or is for nonprofit educational purposes
- 2. The nature of the copyrighted work
- 3. The amount and substantiality of the portion used in relation to the copyrighted work as a whole
- 4. The effect of the use upon the potential market for, or value of, the copyrighted work

The distinction between fair use and infringement may be unclear and not easily defined. There is no specific number of words, lines, or notes that may safely be taken without permission. Acknowledging the source of the copyrighted material does not substitute for obtaining permission.

The 1961 Report of the Register of Copyrights on the General Revision of the U.S. Copyright Law cites examples of activities that courts have regarded as fair use: "quotation of excerpts in a review or criticism for purposes of illustration or comment; quotation of short passages in a scholarly or technical work, for illustration or clarification of the author's observations; use in a parody of some of the content of the work parodied; summary of an address or article, with brief quotations, in a news report; reproduction by a library of a portion of a work to replace part of a damaged copy; reproduction by a teacher or student of a small part of a work to illustrate a lesson; reproduction of a work in legislative or judicial proceedings or reports; incidental and fortuitous reproduction, in a newsreel or broadcast, of a work located in the scene of an event being reported."

Copyright protects the particular way an author has expressed himself. It does not extend to any ideas, systems, or factual information conveyed in the work. The safest course is always to get permission from the copyright owner before using copyrighted material.
