Gun Control Governors Work to “Protect” Against Trump Administration

Several Blue state governors, including Jared Polis, who support strict gun control moved to call special legislative sessions to “protect the rights” of their residents after the election. California Gov. Gavin Newsom called for lawmakers to convene a special session to “Trump-proof” the state. Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker did the same and warned the president-elect, “To anyone who intends to come take away the freedom and opportunity and dignity of Illinoisans... you come for my people, you come through me.”

The governor’s strict gun control law that banned Modern Sporting Rifles (MSRs) and standard capacity magazines was just declared unconstitutional in a major victory after a legal challenge led by NSSF. New York Gov. Kathy Hochul, who recently called Americans who voted for President-elect Trump “unAmerican,” decried the president’s win and said she “will not accept an agenda from Washington that strips away the rights of New Yorkers.” Each governor has an abysmal record of protecting their law-abiding citizens’ Second Amendment rights.

A couple of months ago, we at the Colorado State Shooting Association (the NRA's official state association) started sounding the alarm on a number of threats facing Second Amendment rights on this year's ballot in Colorado. In an effort to defeat these threats, we launched a pro-gun voter turnout campaign targeting low-propensity (would-be unlikely-to-vote) gun owners, hunters, and pro-gun citizens, motivating them to get out and vote for pro-gun candidates.

One of the threats we aimed to neutralize was the prospect of an anti-gun supermajority in the State Senate on top of the supermajority they already held in the State House. Supermajorities in both chambers would have handed the gun grabbers enough power to shut down debate on the floor, cram anti-gun policies through rapidly, and even override the governor's veto. Under those conditions, another attempt at an "assault weapons" ban could pass itself.

Now that most of the votes are counted, and our team is no longer tied up with ballot curing in these tight House races, we are excited to announce that we not only avoided an anti-gun supermajority in the Senate but also flipped three House seats, erasing the supermajority previously held by the anti-gunners in that chamber.

This is a huge win for Colorado's pro-gun movement as the additional power afforded to the State House Democrats by their supermajority was a major contributor to the conditions that enabled the 2024 "Assault Weapons" Ban to pass that chamber before we defeated it in the Senate earlier this year.

The anti-gunners are still going to make attempts at restricting our rights to bear arms. But our movement has consistently demonstrated our ability to fight back and win many battles, even in the minority. With the gun grabbers holding smaller majorities than they previously did, these election results are a clear net gain for the good guys.

We would like to extend our gratitude to all of our members and donors who enabled us to contact thousands of pro-gun voters, driving necessary turnout in every key Senate and House District, including House Districts 16, 19, and 50 — the very seats that were flipped to overcome the anti-gun supermajority in the House. We could not have done it without each of you.

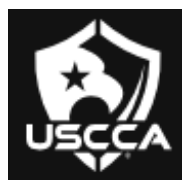
