First Gun Bills of the New Session Arrive at the Colorado Capitol

The Firearms Coalition of Colorado 02-10-2024 Legislative Alert

- **HB24-1015, Suicide Prevention in the Workplace**, Rep. Vigil, Sen. Michaelson-Jenet passed the House Business Affairs and Labor Committee on 01-31-2024 on a unanimous vote. This measure stigmatizes guns and indoctrinates workers against their possession. The bill now goes to the House Appropriations Committee. **We oppose bill as written**.
- HB24-1066, Concerning Methods to Prevent Workplace Violence in Certain Health-Care Settings, Reps. Hamrick and Garcia, Sens. Michaelson-Jenet, and Gonzales. This proposal requires most health care providers and related businesses to create a workplace violence prevention committee and develop a violence prevention plan. It is certain that a ban on firearms will be a part of most plans. This bill is redundant. Many facilities already ban firearms. The measure is up in the House Health Committee on adjournment on Tuesday, 02-27-2024 in House Committee Room 0112 in the basement of the Capitol. Oppose.
- **HB24-1123. Firearm Detection Software for Use in Schools**, Rep. Bradley, Sen. Van Winkle. This measure would facilitate purchase of recognition software to detect exposed firearms using school security camera systems. <u>The bill is up in the House Education Committee upon adjournment on Wednesday, 02-28-2024 in House Committee Room 0107 in the basement of the Capitol. **We support this bill**.</u>
- HB24-1162, Penalty for Theft of Firearms, Reps. Armagost and Snyder, Sen. Zenzinger. This bill makes the theft of a firearm a felony, regardless of the cost of the gun. This bill is up in the House Judiciary Committee at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday 02-14-2024 in House Committee Room 0107 in the basement of the Capitol. We support this measure.
- HB24-1174, Concealed Carry Permits and Training, Reps. Duran and Snyder, Sen. Mullica. This bill will make it more difficult to get a concealed carry permit and require that instructors be certified by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. This bill is up in the House Judiciary Committee at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday 02-13-2024 in House Committee Room 0107. We oppose this bill.
- SB24-003, Authority of the Colorado Bureau of Investigation to Investigate Illegal Activity Involving Firearms, Sen. Sullivan, Rep. Froelich. The bill passed the Senate Judiciary Committee on Monday, 02-05-2024. The bill now goes to the Senate Appropriations Committee. We oppose this bill.
- **SB24-057, Program to Prevent Suicide in the Agricultural Workforce**, Sen. Sullivan, Reps. Froelich and Amabile. This bill will add to the "Guns are bad!" campaign to mold public perception. This bill passed the Senate Health & Human Services Committee on Wednesday, 02-07-2024 on a party line vote. The bill now goes to the Senate Appropriations Committee. **We oppose this measure**.
- SB24-066, Requirement that Certain Businesses with Relationships with Firearms Merchants Use the Appropriate Merchant Category Code, Sen. Sullivan, Rep. Froelich. This measure flags credit card transactions between buyers and anyone who sells firearms or many accessories with a distinct code. This bill passed the Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee on Thursday, 02-08-2024 on a party line vote. It is up in the Senate for Second Reading on Monday, 02-12-2024. Oppose.

SB24-107, Weapons Possession by a Previous Offender, Additional Crimes, Sen. Gardner, Rep. Evans. This bill adds felony convictions for drug making and dealing, and first and second-degree motor vehicle theft to the list of crimes that prohibit a person from owning a firearm. The bill is up in the Senate Judiciary Committee at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, 02-28-2024 in the Old Supreme Court Chambers on the Second Floor of the Capitol. Support.

SB24-131, Prohibit Carrying Firearms in Sensitive Places, Sens. Jaquez-Lewis and Kolker, Reps. Brown, Lindsay, and Froelich. This measure severely limits places where firearms may be carried in Colorado, even with a concealed carry permit. This bill is a direct affront to the US Supreme Court Bruen Decision. It has been assigned to the Senate Judiciary Committee and does not yet have a hearing date. We oppose this bill.

SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Tisas USA has recently learned of a potential safety issue with certain Tisas USA 1911 pistols. Tisas USA is voluntarily initiating a recall of these pistols to protect the safety of its customers due to the possibility of the hammer following the slide forward when chambering a round. While the chance of this occurring is extremely remote, and we are not aware of any injuries that have occurred because of this condition, Tisas USA is immediately implementing this recall of Tisas USA 1911 pistols.

If your pistol falls within the affected serial number range, do not attempt to load or fire your Tisas USA pistol. Doing so could possibly lead to property damage or severe injury.

Tisas USA will upgrade any affected pistols in the order in which it is received for inspection and upgrade pursuant to this recall. Tisas USA will supply affected customers with a return shipping label and will cover any expenses related to the inspection and upgrade of the subject firearms.

Documentation to order ammo includes proof of U.S. citizenship and membership in a CMP Affiliated Club or Special Affiliate (see https://thecmp.org/cmp_sales/eligibility-requirements/ for detailed information).

Customers placing a surplus ammo order through the CMP E-Store will not need to provide Form 2A (those individuals will check a box that states they are not a felon before completing their order). Customers that purchase surplus ammo in-person at our stores or at CMP events must provide Form 2A if they do not have one on file or if it's expired.
