(Bills listed by Number. Please mark your calendar. Only urgent bills listed.)

HB24-1270, Firearm Liability Insurance, Reps. Woodrow and Jodeh, Sen. Hansen. This measure requires all firearms owners to maintain liability insurance. Bill scheduled in House Business Affairs Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday 03-14-2024 in HCR 0112.
Oppose.

HB24-1310, School Safety Measures, Reps. Parenti and Hamrick, no Senate Sponsor. This bill kills the beneficial FASTER Program that trains interested school employees in armed self-defense. The bill is up in the House Education Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday, 03-14-2024 in HCR 0107. **We oppose the bill.**

HB24-1348, Secure Firearm Storage in a Vehicle, Reps. Velasco and Garcia, Sens. Jaques Lewis and Fields. The bill requires storage of firearms in an unattended vehicle in a locked, hard case out of sight in either the passenger compartment or in the trunk. This bill combined with SB24-131 will make it extremely hard to safely carry concealed in Colorado. Bill is up in the House Judiciary Committee at 1:30 pm on Wednesday 03-13-2024 in the Old State Library. **We oppose the measure.**

HB24-1353, Firearms Dealer Requirements and Permit, Reps. Sirota and Bosenecker, Sen. Bridges. In case there are any gun dealers left in Colorado after previous legislation, this bill should cause them to close or leave. The bill adds a state layer of bureaucracy and complexity to current federal rules and regulations. Bill scheduled in House Business Affairs Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday 03-14-2024 in HCR 0112. **Oppose.**

SB24-066, Requirement that Certain Businesses with Relationships with Firearms Merchants Use the Appropriate Merchant Category Code, Sen. Sullivan, Rep. Froelich. This measure flags credit card transactions between buyers and local gun dealers. Bill rescheduled in House Business Affairs Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday 03-21-2024 in HCR 0112. **Oppose.**

SB24-131, Prohibit Carrying Firearms in Sensitive Places, Sens. Jaquez-Lewis and Kolker, Reps. Brown, Lindsay, and Froelich. This measure severely limits places where firearms may be carried in Colorado. Postponed until Wednesday, 03-20-2024 at 1:30 pm in the Old Supreme Court Chambers on the Second Floor of the Capitol. **We oppose bill.**

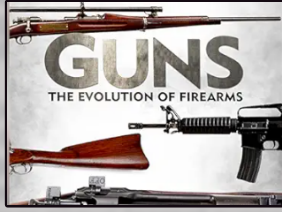
