

The Firearms Coalition of Colorado 04-07-2024 Legislative Alert- Big Week at the Capitol

(Bills listed by Bill Number. Please mark your calendar.)

- HB24-1174, Concealed Carry Permits and Training, Reps. Duran and Snyder, Sen. Mullica. This bill will make it harder to get a concealed carry permit and requires that instructors be certified by the County Sheriff. This bill is up in the Senate State Affairs Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday, 04-11-2024 in the Old Supreme Court Chambers on the Second Floor of the Capitol. We oppose this bill.
- **HB24-1270, Firearm Liability Insuranc**e, Reps. Woodrow and Jodeh, Sen. Hansen. This measure requires all gun owners to maintain gun liability insurance. This is another way to track owners of firearms. <u>Bill passed House Business Affairs Committee</u>. <u>Up in House on Second Reading on Tuesday, 04-09-2024 at 9 am. It is the second bill up</u>. **Oppose**.
- **HB24-1292, Semi-auto Ban**, Reps. Hernandez, and Epps, et. al., no Sen. sponsor. Bill bans manufacturing, importation, sale or transfer of many semi-auto long guns and pistols. Bill passed 03-19-2024 in House Judiciary. Up on Second Reading in House. **Oppose**.
- HB24-1310, School Safety Measures, Reps. Parenti and Hamrick, no Senate sponsor. This bill kills the beneficial FASTER Program that trains interested school employees in armed self-defense. Bill is up in the House Education Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday, 04-11-2024 in House Committee Room 0107 in the Capitol Basement. If you signed up to testify previously, you will need to sign up again. Oppose.
- HB24-1348, Secure Firearm Storage in a Vehicle, Reps. Velasco and Garcia, Sens. Jaques Lewis, and Fields. The bill requires locked storage of a firearm in an unattended vehicle in a case out of sight. This bill will make it hard to safely carry concealed. Bill up Senate State Affairs Committee at 1:30 pm on Thursday, 04-11-2024 in the Old Supreme Court Chambers on the Second Floor of the Capitol. We oppose the bill.
- **HB24-1349, Firearms and Ammunition Excise Tax**, Reps. Duran, Lindstedt, No Senate sponsor. This November ballot measure levies an 11% tax on guns, ammo, and firearm "precursor parts," in addition to the 11% Pittman-Robertson Federal tax. <u>Bill passed House Finance on Monday, 04-01-2024/referred to House Appropriations. No Senate sponsor yet.</u> **We oppose this bill**.
- **HB24-1353, Firearms Dealer Requirements and Permit**, Reps. Sirota and Bosenecker, Sen. Bridges. The bill adds a redundant state layer of bureaucracy and complexity to current federal rules and regulations. <u>Bill up in House Finance Committee on Monday, 04-08-2024 at 1:30 pm in House Committee Room 0112 in the Capitol Basement</u>. **Oppose**.
- SB24-003, Authority of the Colorado Bureau of Investigation to Investigate Illegal Activity Involving Firearms, Sen. Sullivan, Rep. Froelich. Bill creates a state gun police force. The bill is up at 1:30 pm on Wednesday, 04-10-2024 in House Judiciary in the Old State Library between the elevators on the Second Floor. We oppose this bill.
- SB24-066, Requirement that Certain Businesses with Relationships with Firearms Merchants Use the Appropriate Merchant Category Code, Sen. Sullivan, Rep. Froelich. This measure flags credit card transactions with local gun dealers. Passed House on Second Reading. Up in House on Third Reading/Final Passage at 10:00 am on Monday, 04-08-2023. It is the first bill up. Oppose. Bill passed, sent to Governor for signature.

SB24-131, Prohibit Carrying Firearms in Sensitive Places, Sens. Jaquez-Lewis and Kolker, Reps. Brown, Lindsay, and Froelich. This bill bans concealed carry on college campuses. Bill passed Senate. Introduced in House and assigned to House Judiciary Committee. **Oppose**.

NSSF-Adjusted NICS Background Checks for March 2024

NICSThe March 2024 NSSF-adjusted National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) figure of 1,442,061 is a decrease of 7.4 percent compared to the March 2023 NSSF-adjusted NICS figure of 1,556,492. For comparison, the unadjusted March 2024 FBI NICS figure of 2,497,577 reflects a 15.5 percent decrease from the unadjusted FBI NICS figure of 2,954,230 in March 2023. March 2024 marks the 56th month in a row that has exceeded 1 million adjusted background checks in a single month.


